



ARONIA BERRY CULTURAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Aronia Berry will grow in any type of soil and will tolerate both wet and dry soil conditions. They prefer a sunny site but will tolerate partial shade. They should be planted 90cms (36ins) apart.

Aronia Berries are also suitable for container growing. We suggest a pot 60cms (24ins) in diameter and John Innes No 3 compost.

The Aronia Berry has an upright growth and so needs very little pruning. Any pruning that is required to keep the bush to the desired shape and size should be carried out in late winter.
