

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

When to use

Py Spray Garden Insect Killer controls ants, greenfly, blackfly, whitefly, thrips, caterpillars and flea beetles on fruit, flowers and vegetables.

Can be used up to 1 day before picking fruit and vegetables.

Where to use

Py Spray Garden Insect Killer is a contact insecticide. Apply at any time when pests are present. Some varieties of Hydrangea, Dahlia and Crassula may be sensitive to Py Spray Garden Insect Killer. Do not treat young foliage or seedlings. Do not apply in direct sunlight.

How to use

To kill greenfly, blackfly, whitefly, thrips, caterpillars and flea beetles, mix 10 ml per litre of water. Apply as a fine spray, using a pressure sprayer, making sure to thoroughly cover upper and lower surfaces of leaves and stems.

Whitefly require several applications at 4 day intervals to kill newly emerged adults. Pesticide resistance in glasshouse whitefly is widespread. Where whitefly resistance to pyrethrins is present, this product is unlikely to give control.

To kill ants, mix 30 ml per 600 ml of water and apply as a fine spray to ant runs and crevices, plants or lawns where ants are active. This product will control only ants with which it comes into direct contact.

MIXING: Half fill the spray container with clean water. Remove cap above measuring container and gently squeeze to fill it. Empty contents into the spray container. Complete the filling and agitate thoroughly before use.

Protect from frost. Shake well before use.

Py Spray Garden Insect Killer contains 10 g/l (1% w/w) pyrethrins and 40 g/l (4% w/w) piperonyl butoxide.

Toxic to aquatic organisms, may cause long term adverse effects in the aquatic environment.

This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way.
